Application Fees

- Decision Focus: Whether to standardize or differentiate application fees across professions.
- Professions: PE \$110, SE \$110
- WAC Change: Yes WAC 196-26A
- Action Item: *Proposed* Staff to draft language with a new fee schedule standardizing a single application fee for PE and SE.



NCEES - Education Verification

- **Decision Focus:** Approve adoption of NCEES profile (can be accessed by staff without transmittal fee) for all education verification.
- Professions: EIT, PE, LSIT, PLS
- WAC Change: Yes WAC 196-12, 196-20, 196-16, 196-21
- Action Item: Proposed- Staff to draft language requiring applicants to provide verification of education through NCEES profile.



NCEES Record – Work Experience

- Decision Focus: Approve adoption of NCEES record as the required method to verify work experience.
- Professions: EIT (applying without degree), PE
- WAC Change: Yes WAC 196-12, 196-20
- Action Items: Proposed-
 - Staff to draft language requiring applicants to provide verification of work experience through the NCEES record.
 - Staff to provide notifications stating the Board will independently review and reject NCEES-approved experience that does not meet Washington standards. Applicants may be required to complete additional experience verification through BRPELS Experience & Verification Forms.*

Foreign Degree Evaluation Services

- Decision Focus: Approve adoption of NCEES foreign degree evaluation service as the sole accepted service for education equivalency.
- Professions: EIT, PE, LSIT, PLS
- WAC Change: Not necessary. Could be covered in a statement on webpage and or policy.
- Action Items:
 - *Proposed* Staff to draft statement, policy, and or language stating that NCEES is the sole accepted FDE service accepted by the Board.
 - Draft notice for NCEES webpage.
 - Draft accommodation language for alternate FDE use.



Rewrite of "A-H" Criteria for EIT & PE

- Decision Focus: Endorse direction to rewrite criteria as generalized statements of qualifying engineering experience
- Professions: EIT, PE
- WAC Change: Yes WAC 196-12, 196-20
- Action Item: *Proposed-* Staff to draft language amending "A-H" criteria for qualifying work experience.



Supervision for Fed, Mil, & Manufacture

- Decision Focus: Approve exception allowing federal, military, and manufacturing experience verified by unlicensed supervisors with equivalent professional expertise, at the Board's discretion.
- Professions: EIT, PE, LSIT, PLS
- WAC Change: Yes WAC 196-12, 196-20, 196-16, 196-21
- Action Item: *Proposed-* Staff to draft language allowing verification of federal, military, and manufacturing experience by unlicensed supervisors with equivalent expertise & scope.

FE Waiver

- Decision Focus: Approve new criteria for FE waiver to be enacted following legislation passing (RCW 18.43).
- Profession: PE
- RCW Change: Yes RCW 18.43
- **WAC Change:** Yes WAC 196-12
- Action Item: Proposed- Staff to compile approved requirements and draft language for FE Waiver.

FE Waiver – Current Language

WAC 196-12-010-

- (b) Fundamentals of engineering examination waiver shall be granted to an applicant licensed in another jurisdiction provided that:
- (i) The professional engineering license is currently active and is in good standing.
- (ii) The license is in a branch of engineering recognized by the board.
- (iii)The applicant has been actively licensed in a board recognized licensing jurisdiction for a minimum of **10 years** since receiving their initial professional engineering license.



FE Waiver – Future Language
